Queer - Often used to describe the entire LGBTQ community, though the term can be construed as offensive when used by someone who is not a member of that community. (*1) Lesbian - Females who are emotionally and sexually attracted to females.
Gay - Males who are emotionally and sexually attracted to males.
Bisexual - Individuals who are emotionally and sexually attracted to both males and females.

Transgender - Individuals who express a gender identity different from their birth-assigned gender.

Questioning - Individuals who are uncertain about their sexual orientation and/or gender identity. (*2)

Gender is complex; Gender identity is the internal perception of one's gender, and how they label themselves. (*4) Cisgender - Applies to someone whose gender matches their "assigned" sex at birth.
Transgender - Individuals who express a gender identity different from their birth-assigned gender.
Nonbinary - is a spectrum of gender identities that are not exclusively masculine or exclusively feminine—identities that are outside the gender binary of male and female.
Genderfluid - Applies to a person whose gender identity changes over time or changes at different times. (*4)
